1 Important changes in this version

Kerio Connector for BlackBerry

Kerio Connector for BlackBerry allows native over-the-air synchronization of mails, contacts, calendars and tasks between BlackBerry devices and Kerio Connect. Kerio Connector for BlackBerry installs on the same server as BlackBerry Enterprise Server. No additional BlackBerry client on device is necessary, it features native UI of BlackBerry devices.

Supported: BlackBerry Enterprise Server version 5, BlackBerry Enterprise Server Express. All BlackBerry devices supported by BlackBerry Enterprise Server.

Support for Outlook 2010

Kerio Outlook Connector (Offline Edition) supports Outlook 2010. Outlook 2010 is not supported for old, online version of KOC.

Public and Shared Folders in Mobile Devices

Public and shared folders can be synchronized into ActiveSync devices (iPhone, Windows Mobile, etc.). The list of folders which will be synchronized can be managed directly from mobile devices on Integration page or from webmail Settings menu.

Leave POP3 Messages on Remote Server

POP3 delivery now provides ability to leave messages on remote server and, if required, delete it after a certain period.

Mail Retention Policy

Mail retention policy options can be set per user. It is possible to set Sent Items folder. All folders setting now supports days.

CardDAV Improvements

Minor CardDAV improvements among others contain better Address Book support, auto-configuration script bug fixes, better HTTP service setting.

Sophos Antivirus

The internal antivirus has been changed from McAfee to Sophos.

Administration Console is Being Discontinued

Administration Console is not a part of the installation package anymore. Please use the Kerio Connect Administration web interface instead.

If you are using a trial version, you need to register it to get the option to update the internal antivirus.

3 Known Issues

- Using Kerio Outlook Connector (Offline Edition) with Outlook 2010 requires full installation of Kerio Outlook Connector (Offline Edition); sharing of other mailboxes will not work otherwise.
- Kerio Connector for BlackBerry: work with signed and encrypted messages is unreliable.
- Outlook 2010 automatically creates folders "Suggested Contacts" and "News Feed". If they are deleted, they are created again.

4 Upgrade

- Kerio Connect 7.1.0 can be installed on top of any previous Kerio MailServer or Kerio Connect version.
- Kerio Connect will re-create CalDAV and CardDAV databases upon the first startup. It can cause temporary unavailability of calendar and contact items in CalDAV/CardDAV clients.

- Kerio Connect will re-create CalDAV and CardDAV databases upon the first startup. It can cause temporary unavailability of calendar and contact items in CalDAV/CardDAV clients.
